*Please note! We'll be marching from Walnut Plaza to the rally site (about a 12 minute walk).
If you'd rather not walk, you should park closer to the rally site @ 5th & Market.*

How to Get There Via NJ

Here are several options for how to get to the gathering location

Route option #1 – NJ Turnpike to 95 South in PA

NJ Turnpike to Exit 6 to 276 W to 95S to Exit 22 Callowhill. Take exit 22 for Callowhill St. towards I-676 E/US-30 E/Independence Hall

Route option #2 - 295 to Ben Franklin Bridge

Take Interstate 295 to exit 26 -- 76 to 676 Camden Philadelphia -- (exits on the left of 295) Continue North on 76/676 and it will take you straight over the Ben Franklin Bridge Once you are off the bridge stay to the right and look for signs that say "95 New York Chester Next Right"

Stay to the right again to get on 95 South

Route option #3 - Rt 1 to 95

(If Ben Franklin and Walt Whitman are blocked)

Rt 1 bridge through Trenton into PA

Take Rt 1 exit 22 onto 95

Take 95 down to Walnut Plaza

Route option #4 - Tacony or Betsy Ross Bridge to 95

(If Ben Franklin and Walt Whitman are blocked)

These bridges are north of Philly. You could take either (they are close to one another) to get over the Delaware river and onto 95.

Tacony Bridge (Rt 73) or Betsy Ross Bridge that take you from 295 in NJ to 95 in PA.

Route option #5 - Use the Walt Whitman Bridge

(If Ben Franklin is blocked)

This bridge is south of the Ben Franklin, so you would pass the Ben Franklin going south, then cross the Walt Whitman, and come up North on Rt 95 to the staging location.

Route option #6 - Go the long way around

Approach the city from the West by taking Rt 1 all the way down to Rt 76 and take that down to Vine St Express way (676). Be aware that if Trump supporters are trying to disrupt the City, they will target 676 because it is the main East/West artery.

Route option #7 - Take 611 into the City

This is if all else fails. 611 is a busy road with stoplights that goes straight into the center of the city and runs into City Hall.

Public Transportation

Best option is to park at a South Jersey PATCO High Speed line station and take a train (every 20 minutes) to 8th & Market St. in Philly, then walk East on Market. The Woodcrest (Cherry Hill) station with ample parking has its own exit from Rt 295. Less frequent SEPTA trains leave from Trenton & West Trenton. See
